1. T-05.39.PCN (Wayne)

On November 15, 2005 Peter Enterprises, Inc., Manhattan, Montana filed an application for a permanent and temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity. The temporary application was granted and the permanent application was noticed to the public on December 7, 2005. No protests to the

permanent application were received. The permanent grant will replace the temporary authority previously approved.

Class D – Construction debris, between all points and places in Big Sky, Montana and a 20 mile radius thereof to a licensed disposal site.
LIMITATION: Carrier is restricted to the use of 5th wheel trailers and may have no less than 5 or more than 10 trailers.

2. TN2297 (Wayne)

Dick Irvin, Inc., Shelby, Montana requests permission to continue the lease of PSC No. 9392 to Irvin, Inc. & Mico, Inc. dba I & T Transfer, Shelby, Montana for a one year period, January 6, 2006 to January 6, 2007.

SUB F Class B - Property within the town of Fairfield, Montana, and to or from points tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles in any direction from said town, and the transportation of building materials only within a distance not exceeding 150 miles in any direction from said town of Fairfield. Limitation: Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.

SUB L Class B - Property in Oilmont, Montana, and in the oil fields tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles in any direction from said town. Limitations: The transportation of property between points served by rail carriers, or between points served by a motor carrier operating between fixed termini or over a regular route, is prohibited. Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.

SUB M Class B - Property within the City of Conrad, Montana, and to or from points tributary thereto, but within a distance not exceeding fifty (50) miles in any direction from said town. Limitations: The transportation of property between points served by rail carriers, or between points served by a motor carrier operating between fixed termini, or over a regular route, is prohibited. Transportation of ashes, trash, waste, refuse, rubbish and garbage is prohibited.
