On August 29, 2008 Montana Mountain Express Ltd., Big Sky, Montana filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. That application was noticed to the public on September 10, 2008 and

protests were received. The applicant asks that the application be withdrawn and the docket closed.

Cary M. Sarles dba Park County Transportation, Livingston, Montana requests permission to suspend PSC No. 9456 for three months, October 4, 2008 to January 4, 2009.

Class B – Passengers between all points and places within a one hundred twenty-five (125) mile radius of Livingston, Montana. LIMITATIONS: 1) Service in the city limits of Livingston is prohibited. 2) Movements to or from Gallatin Field must originate or terminate in Park County, Montana. 3) Movements in Big Sky, Montana and a twenty-five (25) mile radius are prohibited. 4) Seating capacity will be no more than six (6) passengers per vehicle. 5) Services as a limousine are prohibited. 6) Movements to or from Bozeman, Montana must originate or terminate in Park County and require a one (1) week advance reservation. 7) Transportation to or from Billings, Montana must originate or terminate at Logan International Airport and a three (3) mile radius thereof.
