The Commission on October 9, 2009 issued Order No. 6994a in the above docket. That order required Qwest to continue to produce certain reports for trouble reports regarding voice and DSL service and to file those reports with the Commission. Staff has revisited those reporting requirements. ARM 38.5.3360 provides that:

"...The carrier shall maintain an accurate record of trouble reports made by its customers for a period of two years. This record shall include appropriate identification of the customer or service affected the time, date, and nature of the report, the action taken to clear trouble or satisfies the complaint, and the date and time of trouble clearance or other disposition. This record shall be available to the commission or its authorized representatives upon request at any time within the period prescribed for retention of such records."

Staff believes that in the future, the "on demand" reporting requirements regarding trouble reports contained in ARM 38.5.3360 will provide staff sufficient information to ascertain the quality of service being provided by Qwest if staff receives data (such as an increase in the number of complaints) that suggests issues with the quality of service being provided by Qwest. Staff believes the reporting requirement of Order No.6994a are unnecessary and should be discontinued and Docket No. N2008.12.144 closed.
