NOTICE OF STAFF ACTION GRANTING INTERVENTION

1. On April 2, 2018, Montana-Dakota Utilities filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to maintain its current Conservation Program Tracking Mechanism Rate 90 Tariff. The rate is calculated to recover \$134,915, including \$3,867 of under-recovered expenditures from the 2016 program year (March 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017) and \$131,048 in expenditures from the 2017 program year (March 1, 2017 through February 28, 2018).

2. On April 10, 2018, the Commission indicated that parties interested in intervening with the Application must notify the Commission by April 27, 2018. Subsequently, the Commission received a timely Petition to Intervene from the Montana Consumer Counsel (“MCC”). The Commission grants the MCC’s petition.
