NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND INTERVENTION DEADLINE

On June 4, 2018, Miller Oil Company dba The City Line (“Miller Oil”) filed with the Montana Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an Application to Implement Reduced Rates and Charges to Return Over Collected Propane Gas Costs (“Application”).

The Application is publicly available at the following locations: online at the Commission’s website under Docket No. D2017.2.11; at the Commission’s business offices, 1701 Prospect Avenue, P.O. Box 202601, Helena, Montana 59620-2601; and the Montana Consumer Counsel (“MCC”), 111 North Last Chance Gulch, Suite 1B, P.O. Box 201703, Helena, Montana 59620-1703, telephone (406) 444-2771. The MCC is available to represent the interests of the consuming public in this matter.

The Commission invites any interested person directly affected by Miller Oil’s Application to intervene. To intervene parties must file a petition to intervene with the Commission **no later than October 10, 2018**. Parties must submit: (1) an electronic petition to the PSC’s website at <http://psc.mt.gov> (“Electronic Filing” under “For Regulated Utilities” tab); (2) the original petition by physical delivery or mail to the Commission address stated above; and (3) a hard copy of the petition to the MCC address above and to Miller Oil Company, P.O. Box 408, 120 1st Avenue East, Culbertson, MT 59218. The Commission will not post the electronic document to its website until it receives the original from the petitioner.

The Commission also invites interested parties who do not wish to formally intervene to submit written public comments on the matter to the Commission address stated above, or through its web-based comment form at <http://psc.mt.gov> (“Comment on Proceedings” under “Documents & Proceedings” tab).

The Commission's jurisdiction over this matter is provided in Title 69, Chapter 3 of the Montana Code Annotated, and Title 38, Chapters 2 and 5 of the Montana Administrative Rules, and any prior orders of the Commission relevant to the issues presented.
