On December 15, 2016, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Montana d/b/a Frontier Communications of Montana filed Advice Letter No. MT-16-08 to introduce a new convenience fee of \$4.50 per occurrence if business and residential customers elect the option of making a payment using a company representative.

**Transportation Notice Items:** Motor carriers with proper standing may protest applications. If no written protests are received by the deadline, the Commission may issue a final decision on the application (including a decision by delegation of authority to Commission staff pursuant to established internal operating procedures) without a public hearing, pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. § 69-12-321.
